



2020 Red Rock Rave #1

General Information

1. Parking fees at the Mandalay Bay will be \$12 for 2 to 4 hours, or \$15 for the day.
2. The free tram from the Excalibur Hotel to Mandalay Bay Hotel will run from 6:00AM to 3:00AM during the event.
3. The SCVA will **not** be charging an admission fee for the event.
4. Coolers and chairs will not be allowed inside the halls, unless due to medical necessity
5. There will **not** be water stations due to security reasons in the halls, however water will be for sale for \$2 a bottle inside the halls labeled “Mandalay Bay”, or players may bring in their own water bottles.
6. All food vendors and Starbucks have increased their hours for the event.
7. There will be security in the halls, at the entrance doors, and in the halls during the event. The security will be comprised on members of Mandalay Bay Security, Las Vegas Metro Police, 4 K-9 units, as well as SCVA security.
8. There will be an Emergency Action Plan located at the main Championship Desk in Bayside D
9. The SCVA will not have balls or ball carts to use for warm ups. There will be a ball-pump available if teams need to re-inflate balls after traveling
10. The event will be utilizing 6 halls on the main floor of the convention center:
 - a. Bayside F – courts 1 - 22
 - b. Bayside E – courts 23 – 43
 - c. Bayside D – courts 44 – 68
 - d. Bayside C – Court 69 – 92
 - e. Bayside B – courts 93 – 114
 - f. Bayside A – courts 115 - 120
11. There will be a Championship desk in Bayside E and in Bayside C
 - a. Each desk will have a site director
 - b. Each desk will have a head official
 - c. Each desk will have a results station
12. There will be trainers’ stations in Bayside E and Bayside C
13. There will be an event Arbitrator on duty during the event.
14. There will only be playoffs for teams still in contention for a bid that are tied on matches and games. Please refer to the Championship Manual for specific details.

15. For teams who are no longer in contention for a bid, there will be no playoffs for breaking ties. Ties will be broken by the following criteria:
 - a. Two- way tie – is the head to head win between the two teams that are tied
 - b. Three-way tie – will be broken on game percentage and point percentage.
16. The following are the playing waves for Round 1:
 - a. 16American – PM start
 - b. 16Open – AM start
 - c. 16USA – AM start
 - d. 17American – PM start
 - e. 17Open – AM start
 - f. 17USA – AM start
 - g. 18American – AM start
 - h. 18Open – AM start
 - i. 18USA – PM start
17. For Round 2, the following will be the playing times, however there might be some variations:
 - a. Division 1 (1sts and 2nds from round 1) 8AM start
 - b. Division 2 (3rds and 4ths from round 1) 3PM start
 - c. The exception is that the 18USA may remain a PM start for Division 1 and 2
 - d. All open divisions will be 8AM start
 - e. Challenge matches – In some divisions, teams advancing out of Round 2 toward the gold, will have challenge matches Sunday night.
18. For Day 3, all teams will play in single-elimination brackets beginning sometime in the morning. The SCVA is attempting not to schedule any matches to begin after 3PM. Please note, most courts run behind on the last day as well.
19. On Day 3, once your team loses, they will officiate the next match on their court; not the next match in their playoff bracket.
20. On Sunday, at the awards booth, there will be “Bag Tags” available for all teams to pick up
21. There will be an awards podium. There will be medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams in each division. (Please note, these are teams in the Gold Bracket only).
22. Throughout the event, the SCVA will be collecting any unused toiletries from your hotel stays and donating them to the Priority Prevention Center of Orange County. There will be donation boxes located at the Championship desk in Bayside D.
23. Mandalay Bay will also be providing a room in which you can check luggage on Monday, as we cannot allow luggage in the playing halls, due to safety issues. The rooms will be in the Foyer of Bayside E or F. The room will be run by Mandalay Bay, and not the SCVA.

24. SCVA and Molten have partnered together for a fundraiser for Stand Up 2 Cancer. All proceeds from the sales of the following ball will go directly to Stand Up 2 Cancer.



25. On the final day of competition, all staff, and most officials will be wearing pink to show their support of those fighting, or those who have battled cancer. We ask teams to also show their support by wearing pink on the final day as well. (Please do not endure additional costs to do so, though).
