

Tie Breaking Procedures

For the majority of the event, the SCVA will be using the regional tie-breaking procedures:

- 1. Two way tie (in matches)– head to head results will be used to break the tie**
- 2. Three way tie (in matches)- the tie will be broken by game percentage and then point percentage if necessary**

If teams are in contention for the gold, following round 3, the following tie breaking procedures will be used:

- 1. Two way tie (in matches) – head to head results will be used to break the tie**
- 2. Three way tie (in matches)**
 - a. In the event of a three way tie for first, the team with the best game percentage will take first, and will officiate a one game to 25 between the other two teams fighting for second place.**
 - b. In the event of a three way tie for second, all three teams will play a one set tie breaker to determine the final place in the pool. The team with the best game percentage (or point percentage) will have the first round bye, and will officiate the first round tie breaker.**
