

33rd Annual Las Vegas Classic

General Information

1. Parking fees at the Mandalay Bay will be \$12 for 2 to 4 hours, or \$15 for the day.
2. The free tram from the Excalibur Hotel to Mandalay Bay Hotel will run from 6:00AM to 3:00AM during the event.
3. The SCVA will **not** be charging an admission fee for the event.
4. Coolers and chairs will not be allowed inside the halls, unless due to medical necessity
5. There will **not** be water stations due to security reasons in the halls, however water will be for sale for \$2 a bottle, or players may bring in their own water bottles.
6. All food vendors and Starbucks have increased their hours for the event.
7. There will be security in the halls, at the entrance doors, and in the halls during the event. The security will be comprised on members of Mandalay Bay Security, Las Vegas Metro Police, 4 K-9 units, as well as SCVA security.
8. There will be an Emergency Action Plan located at the main Championship Desk in Bayside D
9. The SCVA will not have balls or ball carts to use for warm ups. There will be a ball-pump available if teams need to re-inflate balls after traveling
10. The event will be utilizing halls on 3 different floors of the convention center:
 - a. The main floor – Bayside Halls D, E, and F will house court 1 – 68
 - b. The upper floor – Shoreline B will house courts 69 – 95
 - c. The lower floor – South Pacific and Islander Ballrooms will house court 96 – 107
11. There is be a Championship desk in Bayside D, Shoreline B, and the South Pacific/Islander halls
 - a. Each desk will have a site director
 - b. Each desk will have a head official
 - c. Each desk will have a results station
12. There will be trainers in each of the halls
13. There will be an event Arbitrator on duty during the event.
14. There will be no playoffs for breaking ties in rounds 1 and 2. Tie will be broken by the following criteria:
 - a. Two- way tie – is the head to head win between the two teams that are tied
 - b. Three-way tie – will be broken on game percentage and point percentage.
15. The following are the playing waves for Round 1:
 - a. 15Open – 8AM start
 - b. 16Club – either 8AM or 3PM start
 - c. 16Open – 8AM start
 - d. 17Club – 3PM start
 - e. 17Open – 8AM start
 - f. 17Open Elite – 8AM start
 - g. 18Club – 3PM start
 - h. 18Open – 8AM start
 - i. 18Open Elite – 8AM start

16. For Round 2, the following will be the playing times:
 - a. Division 1 (1sts and 2nds, and potentially some 3rds after a re-seed, from round 1) 8AM start
 - b. Division 2 (3rds and 4ths from round 1) 3PM start
 - c. Challenge matches – teams advancing out of Round 2 will have challenge matches Sunday night. Teams will be re-seeded prior to the challenge matches, based on match percentage, game percentage, and point percentage of Round 2 pools only.
17. For Day 3, all teams will play in single-elimination brackets beginning sometime in the morning. The SCVA is attempting not to schedule any matches to begin after 3PM. Please note, most courts run behind on the last day as well.
18. On Day 3, once your team loses, they will officiate the next match on their court; not the next match in their playoff bracket.
19. On Sunday, at the awards booth, there will be “Bag Tags” available for all teams to pick up
20. There will be an awards podium. There will be medals for 1st, 2nd, and the two team tied for 3rd in each division. (Please note, these are teams in the Gold Bracket only).
21. Mandalay Bay will also be providing a room in which you can check luggage on Monday, as we cannot allow luggage in the playing halls, due to safety issues
